

# Landscape Construction Foreman

## Job Summary:

The Landscape Construction Foreman is responsible for overseeing all on-site aspects of landscape construction projects. The Landscape Construction Foreman performs a variety of work tasks in order to manage the successful completion of landscape construction projects in accordance with contracted specifications and company policy and standard operating procedures. The Landscape Construction Foreman performs and supervises a crew of laborers in the performance of specified job tasks, as well provides daily documentation of labor, equipment, and materials data.

- Ensure all work is performed in accordance with contracted specifications and company policy and standard operating procedure.
